

RESOLUTION 2010-3-1

WHEREAS, Illinois Governor Patrick Quinn in his 2011 Budget Address proposed a 30% reduction in the Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) to municipalities, and

WHEREAS, the impact of a 30% reduction in LGDF funds to the Village of Pecatonica means a loss of \$48,000 to the Village, and

WHEREAS, the Village has already experienced an 18% decline in LGDF funds the past three years due to the economic downturn, and

WHEREAS, the Village has already cut their budget a substantial amount and will have to do so again if this proposal is passed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Pecatonica, Winnebago County, Illinois, that:

By the adoption of this resolution, Village President Shawn Connors and the Board of Trustees urge the Governor to reconsider this funding cut, and appeal to the General Assembly to not support the LGDF reduction as proposed in the State Budget.

FURTHER, a certified copy of this resolution will be mailed to our State Senators, State Representatives and Governor Patrick Quinn for immediate consideration.
