

ORDINANCE 2010-8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2004 ILLINOIS PLUMBING CODE

WHEREAS, the Village of Pecatonica (“Village”) has adopted the 2004 Illinois Plumbing Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend sections of said Plumbing Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village finds that it is in the best interest of the Village and its citizens to amend sections of the Plumbing Code so that the Plumbing Code better meets the needs and requirements of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village is authorized and empowered by statute to amend and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, WINNEBAGO COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the Pecatonica Board of Trustees.

Section 2. That the 2004 Illinois Plumbing Code as previously adopted by the Village is amended as follows:

- A. All plumbing from the property line to the building has to be done by an Illinois Licensed Plumber.**
- B. All plumbing systems and equipment shall be installed in accordance with the Illinois State Plumbing Code as adopted by the Village of Pecatonica including local amendments. All work shall be performed by State of Illinois licensed plumbers in accordance with the Plumbing License Act.**
- C. Water Service: Water service connection from the cutoff (buffalo box) to the valve after the meter shall be installed by a State of Illinois Licensed and Bonded Plumbing Contractor only. Home owners shall not be allowed to install water service.**

Section 3. To the extent this Ordinance contradicts any previous orders, resolutions, ordinances or parts of orders, resolutions and ordinances of the Village, this Ordinance shall control and all other orders, resolutions, ordinances or parts of orders, resolutions, and ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflicts exist.

Section 4. All other orders, resolutions ordinances or parts of orders, resolutions, and ordinances of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.
