

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-26

ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, "ADMINISTRATION", CHAPTER 31, "BOARD OF TRUSTEES", SECTION 31.16 "PURPOSES, SUBPARAGRAPH (B), "PUBLIC WORKS/PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE", OF THE CODE OF PECATONICA

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois ("Village") have previously adopted ordinances establishing the time and dates for regular board meetings; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities have previously adopted ordinances establishing standing committees of the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities now deem it in the public interest of the residents of the Village to amend its ordinances to separate the standing committee previously known as "Public Works/Public Safety Committee into two separate standing committees of the Board of Trustees as stated herein.

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois.

Section 1. Title III, "Administration", Chapter 31, "Board of Trustees", Section 31.16, "Purposes", subparagraph (B), "Public Works/Public Safety Committee", is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with and shall read as follows:

31.16 PURPOSES.

(B) Public Works Committee.

(1) To address and consider all matters dealing with construction on or maintenance of public property within the village including but not limited to issues involving the construction or improvements of streets, walks, curbs, gutters, public buildings and facilities, snow removal, sewer and water system repairs, the maintenance and finance of same, garbage and waste collection, and any other matters generally related shall be referred to and considered by the Public Works Committee.

(2) The Committee shall review Public Works budgets and make financial recommendations relating thereto to the Finance Committee. The Committee shall make a report and recommendation to the Village Board as a whole, as to what action, if any, should be taken. Any recommendation so made shall not be binding upon the Village Board.

(C) Public Safety Committee.

(1) To address and consider all matters including but not limited to public safety, public health, police department operations, police protection, and fiancé of same, and any other generally related matters shall be referred to and considered by the Public Safety Committee.

(2) The Committee shall review Police Department budgets and make financial recommendations relating to public safety to the Finance Committee. The Committee shall make a report and recommendation to the Village Board as a whole, as to what action, if any, should be taken. Any recommendation so made is not binding upon the Village Board.

Section 2. Title III, "Administration", Chapter 31, "Board of Trustees", Section 31.16, "Purposes", subparagraph (C), "Economic Development Committee", shall now be identified as subparagraph (D).

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
