

**VILLAGE OF PECATONICA
ORDINANCE NO. 2023-12**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 75 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, ILLINOIS REGARDING PARKING
SCHEDULES [ADDING TIME LIMIT PARKING – FOURTH AND MAIN]**

WHEREAS, Sections §72.01 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois (“Village”) authorizes the Village Board to prohibit parking and to post no parking signs on streets within the Village of Pecatonica; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 75 of the Village Code provides for Parking Schedules; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend various parking schedules contained in Chapter 75; and

WHEREAS, the Village finds that it is in the best interest of its citizens to provide enact the above described ordinance and regulations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE
VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA,
WINNEBAGO COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein a made a part hereof.

Section 2. That Chapter 75, Schedule II (Time Limit for Parking), of the Village Code is hereby amended to read **in its entirety** as follows (additions shown as **bolded** and underlined and deletions as ~~strikethroughs~~):

[SEE EXHIBIT “A”]

Section 3. That Chapter 75, Schedule V (Time-Designated Parking), of the Village Code is hereby deleted in its entirety, such provisions therein having been incorporated by the terms of this Ordinance into Schedule II.

Section 4. That the Village of Pecatonica Department of Public works shall cause to be posted signage in compliance with local ordinance and State Statute to properly mark parking restrictions.

Section 5. To the extent this Ordinance contradicts any previous orders, resolutions, ordinances or parts of orders, resolutions and ordinances of the Village, this Ordinance shall control and all other orders, resolutions, ordinances

or parts of orders, resolutions, and ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflicts exist.

Section 6. All other orders, resolutions ordinances or parts of orders, resolutions, and ordinances of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

SCHEDULE II. TIME LIMIT FOR PARKING.

- A) It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle in designated spaces for longer than the posted time periods established in this Schedule.
- B) That where two or more parking restrictions apply to a given location, the more restrictive regulation shall control.
- C) Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this schedule shall be fined the pursuant to §72.99.

Two-Hour Parking.

- A) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a motor vehicle for more than two hours at any time between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., of any day, except Sunday:
 - 1. On either side of Main Street between the north line of Market Street and the north line of Fifth Street;
 - 2. ~~On the south side of West Fourth Street from Main Street to Alley;~~
 - 3. On the north side of West Third Street between Reed and Division Streets; and
 - 4. On the south side of West Third Street between the east end of the Dean Food's parking lot and Division Street.

Ten-Minute Parking.

- A) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a motor vehicle for more than **ten minutes** at any time, of any day:
 - 1. **On the south side of West 4th Street from the corner of Main Street west 42 feet;**
 - 2. **On the west side of Main Street from the corner of 4th Street south for the first 45 feet south of 4th Street.**

Fifteen-Minute Parking.

A) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park any motor vehicle for more than **fifteen minutes** at any time between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday:

1. in the second parking stall on the north side of East Fourth Street east of Main Street;
- ~~2. the first parking stall on the west side of Main Street, south of West Fourth Street;~~
3. in the first two parking stalls on the south side of East Third Street, east of Main Street;

Twenty-Minute Parking.

A) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park any motor vehicle for more than **twenty minutes** at any time between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday:

1. in the fifth parking stall south of Third Street on the west side of Main Street;
2. in the seventh parking stall north of Fourth Street on the east side of Main Street.
