ORDINANCE NO. 2024-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 72.03 TIME LIMIT FOR PARKING OF  
**CHAPTER 72 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA,  
ILLINOIS REGARDING PARKING REGULATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, The Village of Pecatonica ("Village") has adopted a Code of Ordinances ("Code"); and

**WHEREAS**, Section 72.03 of the Village Code provides for limiting the time a vehicle may park in a village parking lot; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village desires to amend Section 72.03 to include public streets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village finds that it is in the best interest of its citizens to limit the time a vehicle may be parked on public streets.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, WINNEBAGO COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**Section 2.** That Chapter 72, Section 72.03, of the Village Code is hereby amended to read **in its entirety** as follows (**additions** shown as **bolded** and **underlined** and **deletions** as **strikethroughs**):

"§ 72.03 TIME LIMIT FOR **PARKING**.

- (A) No vehicle is to be parked in a village parking lot more than **forty-eight (48) consecutive** hours.
- (B) Any such vehicle parked **in a village parking lot** for more than **forty-eight (48) consecutive** hours may be removed by the Police Department and stored at the expense of the owner of the vehicle.
- (C) **Unless a shorter parking time limit is applicable as specified in this chapter or by signage posted on a village street, no person shall park a vehicle on any village street for longer than forty-eight (48) consecutive hours. Village residents must still comply with any applicable shorter parking time limits set forth in this chapter, including, but not limited to, Section 72.06 regarding Snow Emergencies. Any such vehicle parked on a village street for more than forty-eight (48) consecutive hours shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 72.99.**

**Section 3.** That the Village of Pecatonica Department of Public works shall cause to be posted signage in compliance with local ordinance and State Statute to properly mark parking restrictions.

**Section 4.** To the extent this Ordinance contradicts any previous orders, resolutions, ordinances. or parts of orders, resolutions and ordinances of the Village, this Ordinance shall control and all other orders, resolutions, ordinances or parts of orders, resolutions, and ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflicts exist.

**Section 5.** All other orders, resolutions ordinances or parts of orders, resolutions, and ordinances of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 6.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
