

**VILLAGE OF PECATONICA  
ORDINANCE NO. 2024-06**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 153 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, ILLINOIS REGARDING SPECIAL USE PERMITS**

**WHEREAS**, §153.040 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois (“Village”) authorizes the Village Board to regulate Special Use Permits within the Village of Pecatonica; and

**WHEREAS**, §153.040 of the Village Code provides for Special Uses under the Village Zoning Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended §153.040(B) of the Village Code by allowing “Offices, businesses, Dentists, and Professional” to be a Special Use in all Village zoning districts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village desires to amend the provisions contained in §153.040(B) by approving the Planning and Zoning Commission recommendation allowing “Offices, businesses, Dentists, and Professional” to be a Special Use in all Village zoning districts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village finds that it is in the best interest of its citizens to enact the above described ordinance and regulations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, WINNEBAGO COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein a made a part hereof.

**Section 2.** That Chapter 153, §153.040, Use Permits, Purpose, of the Village Code is hereby amended to read as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto (additions shown as **bolded** and **underlined** and ~~deletions as strikethroughs~~):

**Section 3.** Other than the change in line 38 of Exhibit A attached hereto, no other changes are made to §153.040.

**Section 4.** To the extent this Ordinance contradicts any previous orders, resolutions, ordinances or parts of orders, resolutions and ordinances of the Village, this Ordinance shall control and all other orders, resolutions, ordinances or parts of orders, resolutions, and ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflicts exist.

**Section 5.** All other orders, resolutions ordinances or parts of orders, resolutions, and ordinances of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 6.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
