

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL OF PERSONAL PROPERTY DEEMED SURPLUS BY THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, Section 5/11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4) vests corporate authorities with the authority to sell personal property deemed “no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the village” as surplus; and that such sale shall be “in such a manner as they designate, with or without advertising the sale”; and

WHEREAS, it is of the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village that it is no longer necessary, or useful to, or in the best interest of the Village to retain its 2014 Ram 1500, VIN Number 1CRR7XXT9ES418775, (the “Property”); and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to authorize the disposal of the Property by sealed bid in a manner determined by the Chief of Police.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees directs the disposal of said Property if a bid exceeds the reserve amount determined by the Chief of Police.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois.

Section 1. The 2014 Ram 1500, VIN Number 1CRR7XXT9ES418775 is deemed surplus.

Section 2. Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Mayor and Village Board of Trustees find that the Property is no longer necessary or useful to the Village and the best interest of the Village will be served by the disposal of the 2014 Ram 1500, VIN Number 1CRR7XXT9ES418775. The Village Chief of Police, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of the Property through sealed bid at a reserve price determined by the Chief of Police.

Section 3. The Village President or his designee shall be authorized to sign all bills of sale of the surplus property.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
